

## **Visiting Fellowship, Marmara University Population and Social Policies Application and Research Center**

Marmara University Population and Social Policies Application and Research Center (PSP) is currently accepting applications for Visiting Fellows who have an interest in studying multidisciplinary data-based research on population and social issues. The Visiting fellowship program aims to provide an efficient academic environment through a mutual share of expertise in the form of seminars, conferences, and debates. PSP provides research facilities for fellows, including a fully equipped shared office, access to the library, and full participation in the academic and social activities of the Center for a period of one or two semesters in accordance with the needs of research. PSP will also arrange introductions to the libraries and other institutions in Istanbul and Turkey relevant to research needs. PSP will facilitate researcher's inclusion into Turkish academic circles.

Visiting fellows are expected to present their work in seminars and discuss their research informally with members of the Center. Visiting fellows are also encouraged to contribute to seminars, classes, and other teaching and research activities of the PSP.

PSP will support applications to different scholarship programs for visiting scholars, including Türkiye Scholarship and TÜBİTAK scholarship. Due to the financial restrictions of the institution, those who have been granted a scholarship in advance will be prioritized in the admission process.

PSP carries out interdisciplinary studies at Marmara University. Since its foundation in 2021, PSP progressed considerably in its effort to function as an independent resource center and a center of excellence meeting the growing needs for credible, visible, and leading-edge academic voices regarding studies on population and social issues. The Center has been engaged in organizing international academic meetings, conferences, workshops, and solo talks on critical issues. Eminent national and international scholars noted public figures, prominent policymakers, and lawmakers have been frequent participants in the academic activities of the Center. Additionally, PSP organizes brief focused programs and summer schools providing fresh analytical approaches and knowledge to those who work at international institutions, media, think tanks, and governmental agencies and policymakers.

- Research proposal (Must be related topics of the PSP's focus)
- Cover letter (one-two pages including the aim of applying for this program and proposed working schedule)
- Application form
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Writing samples (if any)

We welcome applications from advanced doctoral students, post-doctoral researchers, and senior academics. Applicants from a variety of disciplines (including political science, international relations,

literature, history, law, cultural studies, sociology, economics, etc.) will be considered. We also strongly encourage researchers engaged in comparative work (both within the region and between regions and countries) to apply.
